4.4 Setting up address book entries

INTRODUCTION

Outpost supports an address book that essentially lets you create an alias, or friendly name, for an address.

ACTIVITY

- 1. From Outpost, go to the menu **Setup > Address Book**.
- 2. Click New
- 3. Enter the users name. Use "_" for spaces. Example: for Bob Smith, enter BOB_SMITH
- 4. Enter the packet address
- 5. When done, press **OK**
- 6. Create a message. Instead of filling in the To: Field, click to "**TO**" button next to the To: field. Double-click on the address book entry you want to add. Press OK.
- 7. You can also double-click on the address in the to-field. What happens?

You can also define a distribution list, essentially a list of addresses.

- 1. From Outpost, go to the menu **Setup > Address Book**.
- 2. Click New
- 3. Enter the distribution list name. For this example, use "RACES_STAFF"
- 4. Enter a couple of packet addresses (call signs or email addresses for a couple of your AECs). When done, press **OK**.
- 5. Create and send a very SHORT message to this distribution address.

NOTE: Distribution lists are not limited to call signs or tactical calls. If your BBS supports it (and JNOS does), you can also add email addresses.
